1. Privacy Overview

General information

The following document provides a simple overview of what happens to your personal data when you visit this website. Personal data is any information by which you can be personally identified. Detailed information on the subject of data protection can be found in our privacy statement, which can be found below this text.

Data collection on the website

Who is responsible for data collection on this website?

The website operator is responsible for data collection on this website. Their contact details can be found in this section of this privacy statement entitled "Responsible body".

How do we collect your data?

Firstly, we collect your data when you provide it to us. This may be data that you provide in a contact form.

Other data is collected by your IT systems automatically or with your consent when you visit the website. This is mainly technical data (e.g. internet browser, operating system or time of page view). This data is collected automatically as soon as you access this website.

What do we use your data for?

Some of the data is collected to ensure that the website is error-free.

Other data may be used to analyse user behaviour.

What rights do you have over your data?

You are entitled at any time to be informed free of charge about the origin, recipient and purpose of the personal data we hold about you. You also have the right to request the rectification or erasure of this data. If you have given your consent to the processing of your data, you may withdraw your consent at any time in the future.

You also have the right to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.

2. External hosting

This website is hosted by an external hosting provider. Personal data collected on this website is stored on the host's servers.

This may include IP addresses, contact requests, meta and communication data, contractual data, contact details, names, website access and other data generated through the website.

We use the storage space for the purpose of fulfilling a contract with our potential and existing customers (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR) and for the secure, fast and efficient provision of our online offer by a professional service provider (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).

If you have given your consent to this, the data processing will be based solely on the fingerprinting of your device pursuant to Article 6 (1) a) DSGVO and Article 25 B) TTDSG. Consent may be withdrawn at any time.

Our data controller will process your data only to the extent necessary to fulfil its performance obligation and will follow our instructions regarding the data.
